

How to Install WebUpdate.OCX Manually

- 1. Close all instances of Internet Explorer and Microsoft[®] Office.
- Locate and delete the WebUpdate Control file from the following directory: C:\WINDOWS\Downloaded Program Files
- 3. Designate a target installation directory. We would recommend the following:

C:\Program Files\XDimensional Technologies

4. Download the **Ole Control Extension (OCX)** from the location below and save it to the designated installation directory:

http://servername/OI/AutoWebUpdate/WebUpdate.ocx

5. Use the command-line tool, **regsvr32** to register the .dll as a command component in the registry manually.

To access the DOS prompt/command line:

- Windows 2000/XP: Go to the Start menu and click Run, type CMD and click OK.
- Windows 95/98/Me: Go to the Start menu and click Run, type command and click OK.

From the DOS prompt, enter the following commands:

cd C:\Program Files\XDimensional Technologies

regsvr32 WebUpdate.ocx

We strongly recommend uninstalling previous versions of OI as older versions of the OI COM may still be hooked to Microsoft Office. If you do not uninstall these older versions, the overall performance of Microsoft Office will slow down. You will need to consistently follow the above steps every time a new version of the OCX is released by XDimensional Technologies[®].
