





Desktop Resolution Setting

The minimum desktop resolution setting for Nexsure is 1024 X 768. The resolution can be changed to take advantage of the size of the monitor being used. For example, if a widescreen monitor is being used, it is possible to modify the setting to fit more content on the screen. To change the resolution access the Display Settings and try different settings until the desired one is found.


For example, when the screen resolution is set to 1024 X 768, depending on the monitor being used, the client's **attachments** tab might display as follows.



If the scroll bar at the bottom of the screen is not desired, try the next higher available resolution.




In this example, setting the screen resolution to 1280 X 720 displays without the scroll bar.




Microsoft® Windows® XP Display Settings

1. To set display settings for Microsoft Windows XP, right-click on the desktop and select **Properties**.





2. Click the **Settings** tab on the **Display Properties** dialog and move the **Screen resolution** selector to the right toward **More** until it changes by one resolution size.



3. Click **OK**.

Note: View the Nexsure screens to make sure the setting selected is the desired screen resolution. If not go back to the display settings and try a different one. Do this until the perfect setting for you is found but make sure to not go below the minimum Nexsure required setting of 1024 X 768.
